## Community Planning Assistance for Wildfire (CPAW) Program



CPAW works with communities to reduce wildfire risk within the wildland-urban interface (WUI) through improved land use planning.

This fall, five communities will be selected through a competive grant application process to receive technical assistance to reduce wildfire risk within their WUI.

Through the CPAW program, communities are provided with assistance in the form of land use planning, forestery expertise, policy specialists, and risk and hazard modeling. Assistance comes at no-cost to the community and all recommendations are voluntary. Community selection is based on criteria such as wildfire history, community need, and capacity.
