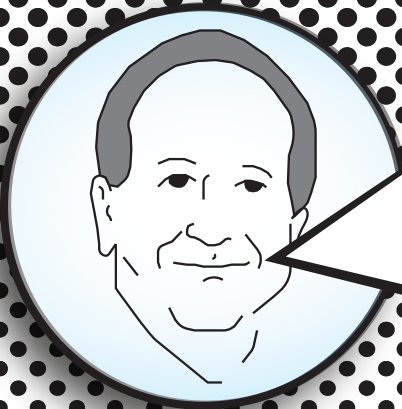


THE APA WASHINGTON 2017-2019 BIENNIAL REPORT





Welcome to the 2017-19 Biennial Report!

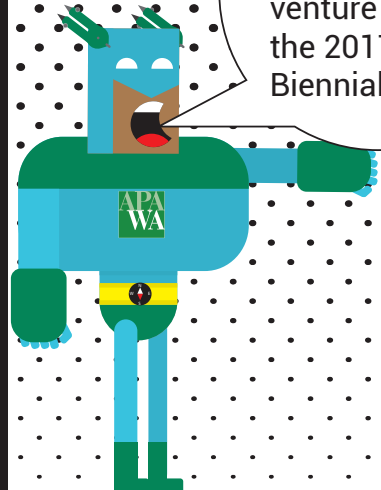
