May 10 - 22	Committee review and determination of candidates to be nominated by Chapter; all submitters will be notified of their status.
June/July	Committee will mentor and assist candidate(s) designated for Chapter nomination with their preparation of applications.
June/July	Candidate must solicit 10+ letters of recommendation to ensure 10 will be submitted by July 31st; candidate must prepare headshot photograph.
July 31	First draft of <b>complete</b> packet (including letters & headshot) due to committee for review and comment.
August 1-10	Mentors offer comments/suggestions/critiques; nominee(s) refine/revise application per mentor guidance.
August 15	Final day for <b>complete</b> application package, including recommendation letters and headshot photograph, submitted to Chapter office and committee chairs.
August 20	Final nomination package submitted to APA National
