





2.3.1 Equipment not recommended

Some playground equipment is not recommended for use on public playgrounds, including:

- Trampolines
- Swinging gates
- Giant strides
- Climbing ropes that are not secured at both ends.
- Heavy metal swings (e.g., animal figures) These are not recommended because their heavy rigid metal framework presents a risk of impact injury.
- Multiple occupancy swings With the exception of tire swings, swings that are intended for more than one user are not recommended because their greater mass, as compared
