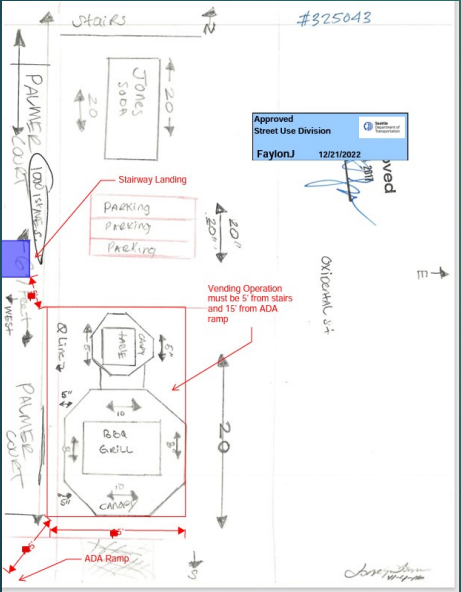
Conditions of Use:
 CD16: Permitted and operating vendors shall comply with Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 15.17, Vending in the Public Place, current SDOT Director's Rule: Vending in the Public Place, and Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 25.08, Noise Control. Permitted and operating vendors shall only occupy and operate in the public place per the approved site plan and during permitted dates, days, and hours, and shall not leave their vending unit unattended for more than 30 minutes. Permitted and operating vendors shall ensure the vending activity does not impede pedestrian mobility, and shall ensure the pedestrian clear zone is kept free of any objects including vending accessories, portable signs, and dividers. Permitted and operating vendors shall ensure the duration of their permit, City, State, or County permits, licenses, and certificates required for their vending activity and activities. Permitted and operating vendors shall be responsible for complying with Title III of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Permitted and operating vendors shall keep a copy of the issued SDOT permit available within the vending unit whenever operating in the public place. CD40: Permitted and operating vendors shall not use anyification or noise-making devices when operating under this permit. Permitted and operating vendors shall comply with Seattle Municipal Code Title 17, Vehicles and Traffic. Permitted and operating vendors shall ensure that customer queues, displays, and vending activity do not encroach into the roadway, or cause pedestrians to divert from the adjoining pedestrian zone. Permitted and operating vendors shall ensure the adjoining and abutting public place is kept free of all refuse of any kind generated from the operation of their business. If food is served, the Permittee and operating vendors shall supply, maintain, and regularly empty refuse containers for public use in capacity of accommodating all patron generated by the vending activity. Permitted food vendors shall comply with all applicable requirements of Title 1 of King County Board of Health Code. Food vendors that sell pre-packaged products, produce, or food or beverages that are capable of immediate consumption. This permit is not transferable. Permittee shall notify SDOT when their business closes or is sold to a new owner.

VENDING NOTES

- A vending permit is required for any food or flower vending or display on sidewalks and in streets.
- Merchandise vending is not permitted, except in the Stadium Vending Zone.
- The sidewalk must be kept clear for people walking, in wheelchairs, or with strollers to easily pass.
- Vending on the street or sidewalk without a permit is a code violation that could result in citations or other escalated enforcement actions.

Temporary Use Permits in Seattle

Updated May 27 2022

There are several types of temporary use permits allowed under the Seattle Land Use Code. These permits allow you to conduct temporary activities (i.e., activities not normally allowed in your zone. Under the Land Use Code, "use" means "the purpose for which a structure is designed, built, arranged, intended, occupied, maintained, or leased," including uses without structures in Seattle.

If your project involves a temporary use that needs a temporary structure, please read Tip 306, Temporary Structures in Seattle.

TYPES OF TEMPORARY USE PERMITS

Our temporary use permit decisions are classified into different categories based on the amount of decision allowed under the Land Use Code (Section 23.42.040) and the level of impact associated with each decision. "Type I" decisions require discretion, but are non-appealable. "Type II" decisions require discretion and public notice and are appealable to the City Hearing Examiner.

For some uses and some structures you will need Fire Department review, environmental review (SEPA), or Special Events Committee review. If your property is within 200 feet of a shoreline, you need to be aware that we do not allow temporary uses in the Shoreline District.

Examples of Type I and Type II projects are:

Type I

- Temporary uses for four weeks or less
- Renewal of most types of temporary use permits for up to six months

Type II

- Temporary relocation of police and fire stations for 12 months or less
- Temporary uses that occur intermittently (e.g., weekly farmers markets) for up to one year, as long as they occur no more than two days per week and do not build a permanent structure
- A boat-building shelter, with no permanent structure, for up to one year
- Uses and facilities to construct a light rail transit system for so long as is necessary to support construction of the system

DECISION CRITERIA

SDCI can make a decision on a Type I temporary use up to four weeks or a Type II temporary use up to six months for a use not otherwise allowed if all of the following are met:

- The proposal meets the intent of the Land Use Code
- There is no permanent structure
- The use does not pose a life, safety, or property threat
- For boat building shelters, the following regulations also apply:
 - The boat shelter is for personal (noncommercial) use
 - The revocable permit is for one year; SDCI may grant one-year extensions for up to four years (for a total of five years);
 - The structure must be sturdy enough to withstand difficult weather conditions
 - SDCI may limit height, site, location, and external structural to reduce possible adverse impacts
